Composition:	Monoclinic crystals of aluminium and iron. Zinc sulphate

Application:

Spray

- Apply 2-3 times per week directly on problem areas with a knapsack sprayer or similar sprayers. Do not dilute the product. Avoid washing the hoof area before and after treatment.
- It is recommended to apply HooFoss spray during milking in milking parlour or carousel. Can also be used for heifers.
- After a few weeks of treatment, the problem areas will appear black with a scab, which should not be removed. This indicated a good effect, and treatment should be continued.
- Non-organic product, which can be used for organic farming according to the council regulation (EF) No. 834/2007. Not to be discharged to the slurry.

Hoof bath

- Use twice per week in a suitable hoof bath with low nonslip profiles in the bottom. We recommend the HooFoss bath (200 x 85 x 15 cm).
- Place the hoof bath on a fully levelled surface.
- 30-40 litre of concentrated HooFoss is poured into the hoof bath. Top up with 10-20 litre of pure water to a liquid depth of 4-5 cm.
- For larger herds top up with 10-20 litre of concentrated HooFoss for every 200 cows.

Hoof mat

- Use twice per week in a suitable hoof mat with a waterproof holster.
- Place the hoof mat with holster on a fully levelled surface and add 25-30 litre of concentrated HooFoss. For larger herds, add extra HooFoss after every 200 cows.
- Manure, primarily from the hooves, may accumulate on the hoof mat. If needed, this can be scraped off during milking.
- Wash the mat surface with water after use (Do not use a high-pressure cleaner) and force liquid out by walking over the mat several times. Hang up to drain.

In general

- Allow HooFoss to dry for a couple of minutes, before letting cows into deeper layers of manure/slurry/water puddles. This can best be achieved by keeping the exit aisle from the milking area clean.
- HooFoss is not affected by manure.
- After a couple of weeks of treatment, problem areas will appear black, which must not be removed. This is an indication of good effect, and treatment should be continued.
